

Training Requirements for Forest Service Projects

- Forest Service Volunteer Application needs to be completed for 2017 complete lines 1 thru 6, 10, 14 and sign and date at the bottom. - 2. Defensive Horse Safety is required for anyone working with or around stock. Defensive Horse Safety is good for 3 years.
- 3. Read the Job Hazard Analysis (JHA's) and sign off on the Master Sheet attesting that you have read them. There are three of them to read and are as follows:
 - a. Stock Use and Handling JHA
 - b. Chainsaw, Crosscut and Hand Tools Use JHA
 - c. Backcountry Work Environment JHA
 - d. Facility maintenance JHA
 - e. These are always available on our web site at http://www.nwmtbch.org/documents
- 4. Chain Saw Certification is required before any member is allowed to use a chain saw on a project
 - a. Each person using a chain saw must also have a current First Aid and CPR certification.
 - b. Each person using a chain saw must use the required safety equipment.
- 5. Crosscut Saw Certification is required before any member is allowed to use a crosscut saw on a project.
 - One person on the crew must have a current First Aid and CPR certification.
- 6. Only one person on a project is required to have a current First Aid & CPR Certification (with the exception of a Chain Saw Crew)
